Women's Division 1 Grand Final Preview

One year after Ascot won its long-awaited maiden Division 1 title, University of Queensland has the chance to hold aloft the premiership shield for the first time in club history.

While the students have never before qualified for the "big dance", Easts is contesting a fifth grand final in eight years. Finishing fifth on the ladder, Easts advanced to the grand final by winning three sudden-death finals, including two in a shootout.

How each team's young players handle grand final pressure could determine who is victorious. The likes of Rhiannon Baxter, Emily Caton, Kelly McNamara, Rhyleigh Brown and Claire Ait Oumeziane (UQ) will take on Genevieve Ferguson, Jade Smith, Siubhan Slater, Chloe Clark and Ruby Harris (Easts).

Only two UQ players – Jamie Stone and Morgan Gallagher – have played in grand finals but the Minor Premiers boast the experienced Caitlin Day and Queensland goalkeeper Hannah Astbury. Lauren Schulte, Lindsey Howard, Kirra Smith, Samara Johnston, Jess Pembroke and Aleesa Ferguson played in Easts' last grand final appearance in 2015.

Expect Easts duo Morgan Mathison and Layla Eleison and UQ's Meg Pearce and Tiana Barrett, the competition's top scorer, to influence today's result. If the grand final ends in a draw, Easts will have confidence in goalkeeper Jessica Switzer's form in one-on-one shootouts.

In a major blow for Easts, top scorer and Queensland player Georgia Hillas will miss the grand final through suspension and Beck Greiner, denied a debut game for Australia this weekend with a fractured thumb, could be a surprise starter for UQ.

Easts and UQ have one win apiece in head-to-head meetings this season – Lee Oliver.

Men's BHL1 Grand Final Preview

When it comes to sentimental favourites playing on grand final day it's hard to go past a team contesting the premiership game for the first time in 43 years. Standing in the way of Pine Rivers St Andrews ending the second longest men's Division 1 title drought, stretching back to 1975, is defending champion Easts.

This season Easts, winner of four grand finals in the past five years, eclipsed its own goals for-and-against record set in 2017. The Minor Premiers boast a star-studded line-up that includes Australian Kookaburras legend Mark Knowles, fellow national team players Scott Boyde and Robert Bell and no fewer than seven Queensland Blades talents.

Making winning today a harder task for the Saints, Jacob Anderson will miss the grand final after being called up to debut for Australia in Darwin this week. In his absence, the likes of Tom Madden, Josh Mynott, Lachlan Brownhalls, Andrew Butturini, Nathan Case and Jason Hullick will need to stand tall for the underdoos.

Both sides have numerous scoring sources with Bell, Boyde, Arin Doig and Jacob Webber each scoring more than 15 times for Easts this season. Rookies Liam Hart and Zac Profke and the experienced Liam de Young and Luke Reddiex contributed more than half of Saints' goals between them.

Pine Rivers St Andrews is one of only two teams to have beaten Easts this season, winning 2-1 in Round 4 before Easts won 5-3 in Round 13 – Lee Oliver.
